

**WARNING**: Install THERMALINE beside rather than under mobile home to facilitate service of unit.

- Install THERMALINE so that outlet is 4 inches above grade or to the specifications of the local plumbing code and so that the valve body is below all danger of frost.
- 2. Flush gravel, debris, etc. out of the supply line before connecting hydrant.
- 3. To protect the hydrant supply connection from ground heaving or settling, connect the THERMALINE to water supply pipe with brass fittings and a flexible supply line.
- 4. After installation, check all connections for leaks.
- Follow winterizing instructions under THERMALINE cover when unit is not electrically heated or unit may freeze and burst.

NOTE: Using the THERMALINE for an electrical ground is a violation of the NATIONAL FLECTRICAL CODE.
