





IMPORTANT NOTICE - READ CAREFULLY

Stainless Steel Saddles Installation Instructions

1. Check the outside diameter of the pipe to make certain the correct saddle is being installed.
2. Clean pipe surface so that the surface is smooth, free of dirt or other debris.
3. Apply a water based lubricant to the face of gasket. Do not use petroleum based lubricants.
4. Loosen nuts, disengage lifter plate and mount saddle on the pipe in desired position. Reengage lifter bar to side bar plate.
5. Torque all nuts to 60 ft. lb. evenly in an alternating sequence.
6. Install corporation stop (See corporation stops-installation instructions).
7. Check torque on all nuts and retighten to 60 ft. lb. if required.
8. Pressure test service line before backfilling.


