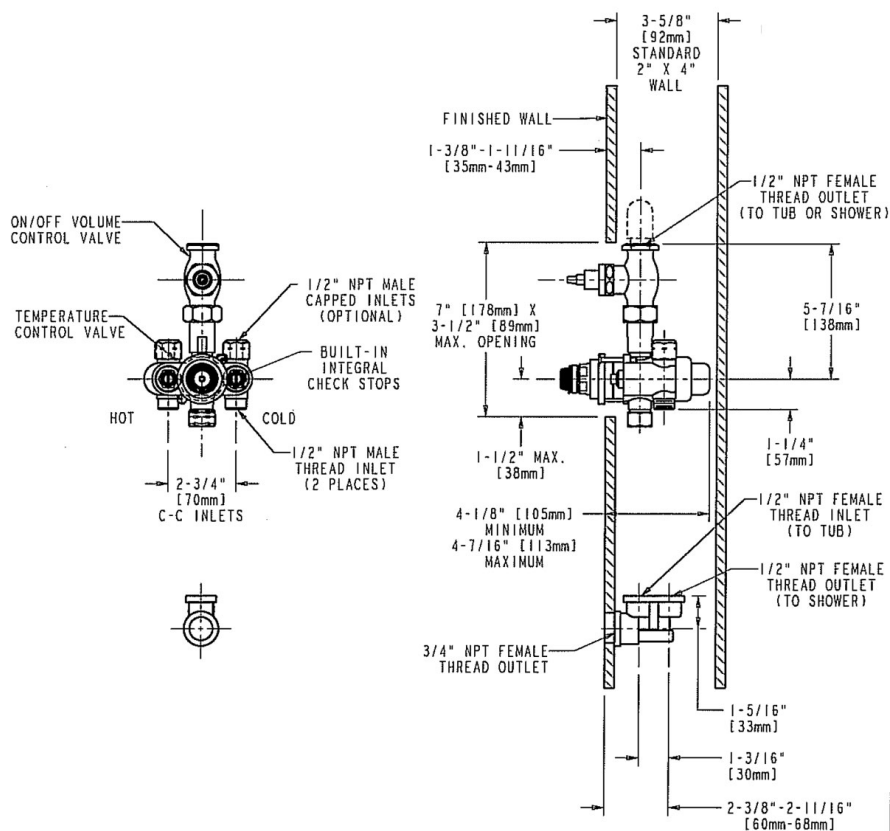

Chicago Faucets No. 2500-VOCP, TempShield Tub and Shower Valve, thermostatic/pressure balancing, wall-mounted. 1/2" NPT male thread valve body inlets. 1/2" NPT female thread valve body outlet. TempShield thermostatic/pressure balancing valve with Quatern™ cartridge for on/off control. Built-in integral check stops. This product is tested and certified to industry standards: ASME A112.18.1/CSA B125.1, and ASSE 1016.



### Operation and Maintenance
